- Parts of stories in reading and writing our own!

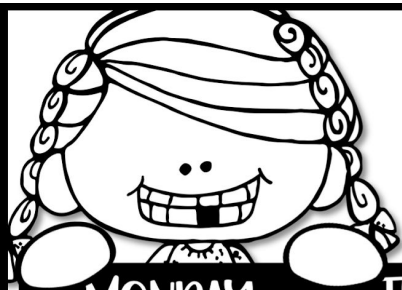
