Bible Unit

In Bible this month we looking at the story of Jacob and seeing the many ways God used him, even after he lied, cheated and stole. Through this unit we are looking at what character traits we should have in our lives, things like being faithful, honest, and righteous and what these traits look like when they are turned into actions.

Look at What We're Learning

Math

Students have moved into learning about addition and subtraction. This year we will be focusing on adding and subtracting numbers inside 1000.

Language Arts

Students are continuing to learn different reading strategies they can use to help them read accurately and with better comprehension. They are also practicing fluency by reading aloud to each other once a week.

Students are working on learning the patterns of English in Word Work using the Words Their Way program.

We have started learning how to write clear, specific descriptions to help our stories come alive to the reader. We will also be learning how to flip our sentences to make the writing flow smoother.

Social Studies

Students have moved on to learning about different public services, such as running water, police, healthcare, and how they impact a person's quality of life. Next we will be examining the culture of each of our four countries (Peru, Tunisia, Ukraine, and India) and how we all express ourselves differently.

Science

Just this past week students started learning about Hearing and Sound. We will be examining how sound is made, how it travels, and how God designed our ears to hear the different sounds he has created.

Health

Students have started learning about their emotions and how to identify them using the ZONES of Regulation program.


