February Learning Focus

Bible: God's Concern for You (every detail of our lives was designed by God), Inner Character, Humility: Doing Things God's Way (study of Beatitudes)

Math: Measurement (calendar, analog clocks and elapsed time, measuring area, area in cm^2 and m^2), Fractions and Decimals, ongoing multiplication skills

LA: Cursive; narrative and expository writing, literature circles, visualizing, plurals, homophones, rhymes, abbreviations

Social: Alberta: The Stories, Histories, and People

Science: Building Devices and Vehicles that Move

Science Fair
