Look at What We're Learning

Math

We will be spending the rest of January on our Data Analysis unit. Students will learn how to collect, share, and interpret data using tally charts, pictographs, and bar graphs.

Language Arts

Students are working on individual goals for reading and will be meeting regularly one on one with Mrs. Vanden Pol to check their progress and learn new reading strategies.

Students are working on learning the patterns of English in Word Work using the Words Their Way program. They are demonstrating more and more confidence with finding and discovering patterns.

This month we will be starting our main event unit. Students will learn how to take a small event and tell it in slow motion adding description, dialogue, thoughts, and feelings to help the reader experience the story and make it more entertaining.

Social Studies

Students are going to be looking at leaders and decision making in each of the four countries. We will talk about voting for leaders, characteristics of a good leader, and how we can be leaders in our lives as well.

Science

We are starting our building unit this month. Students will be getting a chance for some hands on learning as we explore different building materials. We will become engineers and try building different structures that are strong and stable.

Students are going to be discussing problem solving strategies and solutions in Health this month.


