LA Writing - Main Event and Extended Endings

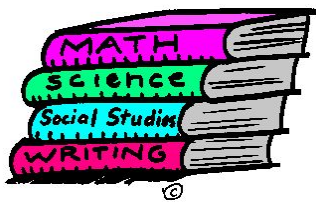
