(This is just a short summary)

Math: number patterns, odd/even numbers, addition, subtraction, measurement, data analysis, 3D shapes, double digit addition and subtraction.

LA: reading, writing, spelling, listening, speaking, printing, cursive, viewing, representing and responding to text.

Social studies: Iqaluit/Nunavut, Saskatoon Saskatchewan, Meteghan/Nova Scotia communities.

Health: safety, nutrition, dental health, regulating feelings, getting along with others.

Art: guided drawing, creating with various materials, view art/appreciation, elements of art.

Bible: Books of the Bible, Bible verse recitation, Storyline (Happy Campers on God's Campground), Who lines- identifying individuals in the Bible that exhibit through-lines characteristics, and characters in the Old and New Testament.

Homework expectations

Students should read daily. Students will have access to online reading resources (get epic and reading eggs and guided readers program). Please keep an eye out for online reading access. Make sure the office and myself have the correct email address.

We will have differentiated spelling tests every Thursday. Students will be assessed and placed at a just right spelling group during the first month of school. Students will receive words on Fridays to practice for the next week. Words can also be found on our class website in case of absence. We will be using spelling city for spelling tests instead of written tests. We will have practice time in class. Students will have access to spelling city at home to practice typing spelling tests. This will take a little practice but is excellent skill to learn. Also this allows students who are absent to still complete the spelling test online if they wish.

We will have a monthly Bible verse. Students will be asked to recite verse end of the month. Please keep the laminated list of verses in a safe place. They will also be on the class website.

Entry and Exit

Entry and dismissal:

Grade 2

Entry: 8:00 Students will come to the side door facing the playground (same door as last year). Look for the pylon labeled 2. Students will line up and wait for their turn to enter the school as a cohort. Parents are encouraged to remain in their vehicle when that is not possible they will be required to mask, social distanced and remain outside the school due to covid restrictions.

Dismissal: 2:40 Bus students will be led to their bus by a teacher or supervisor. All other grade 2 students will be led by teacher to the fence by the C-can at front of the school. Parents make eye contact with teacher and then the child will be released by the teacher into the parents care. Please prepare students that they can not run to parents upon seeing them to keep everyone safe.

** It is very important to be on time for pick up.

Lunch

There is no microwave use allowed due to safety protocols. Students should bring a thermos if they require warm food.

This year due to covid restrictions lunches of any kind can not be delivered to the school. Students must come to school with their lunch packed. In the event a student forgets their lunch a small snack can be provided by the school.

Due to covid restrictions we cannot share food. This means students must refrain from bringing in treats to share for birthdays.

The safety of our students at FMCS is of the utmost importance. We have put procedures and rules in place to keep your child as safe as possible during the school day.

School Materials

In grade 2 students will bring in all school supply materials and they will be stored separately. Please send materials ready to use. Taking materials out of the packages at home will help make the process of storing your child's materials more efficient and less time consuming. Please refrain from sending personal items such as sports equipment and toys with your child to school.

Protocols/Procedures

Masks are recommended for close contact areas such as close play, hallways and buses but not required in grade 2. Please do what works best for your child and your family. If your child chooses to wear a mask please send a baggy or container to keep the mask when they are not wearing it. For example when they are sitting in their desk working or eating they do not wear a mask. It is very important to complete the daily screen before coming to school. This can be obtained in the district and school back to school document or a copy can be found at the office. If your child has any symptoms please keep your child home. If your child shows symptoms at school they will be provided with a mask and they will be directed to the office to be pick up immediately by parents or emergency contact.
