
Scholastic Orders

★ School Website - Please remember to check the school <u>website</u> and our social media pages to stay up do date on important information.




★ Nut Aware School - We are a nut aware school which means students should avoid bringing any type of nut product for snacks and lunch.

Oil pastel art inspired by Cree artist George Littlechild. Each student chose an animal they love and made a brightly coloured whimsical drawing of that animal.

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




