

Beauty Creating

Beauty awakens us. It reminds us of our noble heritage. And these reminders are everywhere! They are literally shouted by the world around us – by "the plants, rocks, animals, sea creatures, insects, the skies and beyond, and especially people" (TfT Handbook) we experience on a day-to-day basis. Like the psalmist David, we praise Him "because [we] are fearfully and wonderfully made" (Psalm 139:14), and do so by engaging in creative acts of our own that reflect His goodness. More than flattery, our imitation of God's creative works can be an act of worship. In this way, our cooking, constructing, writing, moving, playing, planting, designing, and working is redeemed and can be something beautiful in His sight.

We are called to be Beauty-Creators, and as we take up this calling, we have the opportunity to awaken in others their "noble roots as image-bearers created in goodness" (DeGroat), and restore brokenness in our world. Our art, music, and stories – in the hands of the great Redeemer – can be used for such grand purposes! As such, at Cedars, we seek to stimulate, encourage, develop, and "fan into flame" (2 Timothy 1:6) the gift of creativity in our students – that they may serve the Creator and engage in restorative work in His Kingdom. May He continue to bless this work and use it for His glory.

SCRIPTURE READING — MATTHEW 7:24-27

Everyone who hears these words of mine and puts them into practice is like a wise man who built his house on the rock. - Matthew 7:24

Have you ever seen pictures of a house fallen into the sea after a storm washed away its foundation? I can't imagine what it would be like to watch the house I call home ruined by a storm. It must be devastating and make you feel so helpless.


Jesus gives some building advice in the parable we have read today. But he is talking about more than building houses. He is talking about building our lives and making sure their foundation is firm, made up of wisdom and faith in him.

This foundation requires two things. It first involves listening to Jesus' words. Listening is really important and can be hard to do. I work with students a lot, and getting them to listen to instructions isn't always easy. Listening often means putting aside our own ideas or agendas and paying attention for a while.

But listening is only the first step in the foundation of our faith lives. The next step is doing what he asks of us. If we only listen and don't do what is asked, we haven't really accomplished anything. Our faith can be filled with knowledge and belief, but if it isn't tied to action, it rings hollow. Doing is really important!

Is the house of your life built on the foundation of faith that involves both listening to what Jesus is saying and doing what he asks? That is the way of life Jesus is calling us to.








From Our Librarian








During the beginning of April our Grades 1-7 played an Easter guessing game during their library class. It was a lot of fun!

Our two students were invited to attend the Words in Motion Gala at the end of April and their poetry will be printed in the 2021/22 Words in Motion poetry book.




