GOAL 1: NUMERACY

NUMERACY – Math running records will be implemented to be used in conjunction with MIPI to identify student areas of need and growth, as well as inform instruction and the organization of targeted cross grade strategy groups.

We anticipate growth in instructional capacity as well as student growth in identified areas of need based on MIPI and math running record results.





GOAL 2: LITERACY

Cross-grade collaboration to develop and align the literacy continuum of support practices and the implementation of these strategies to inform instructional practices and communicate student growth and areas of need in the area of literacy.

Student skill growth and development will have improved through explicit teaching and targeted intervention based on data analysis and continuum of support strategies as indicated on F & P running records and classroom assessments.
