- a. Education plan discussion - It has been noted that numeracy and literacy in Div 1 kids are struggling. Seeing improvement in literacy as this school year goes on, but numeracy, not so much. It's very consistent across the board, not just at the Christian school. Mental health issues - Our school as a whole is seeing some of this but not as much as the rest of the district. The stats are going down with building community in the school. The school uses data from the provincial governments survey they send out. This year there were issues with delays in people getting their survey in the mail. This could be a potential issue in the fall as we will not have as much data as usual when making decisions such as the education plan for the school.

- c. Freezie friday - will happen in June. There are 4 moms interested in doing this, is there money for this? Geoff has money for this in nutrition and will check and see what is left. Discussion about August being a good time to get parents to meet the teacher and parents before school starts.
