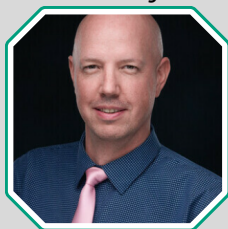

This year, the Fort McMurray Christian School's yearlong school theme is: **We Will Go!**

Why do we have Christian Programming Fees, and why do I need to pay them?

Your Christian Programming Fees are different from - and in addition to - the school fees from FMPSD and are in place to finance the components that make our school a Christian school. This includes having a Christian Education Coordinator on staff; providing Christian resources and teaching materials for classrooms; providing Christian professional development for staff; enabling Christian experiences for our students such as the Walk with Jesus event last year at Easter, and ServeYMM, which was organized by our school and society for the students in our school and greater community.

These fees are a part of attending our school and pertain to students in Kindergarten through to Grade 9. Your attention and faithfulness to this matter is greatly appreciated. If you are experiencing financial hardship and unable to pay, we are here to help and financial assistance is available. Please contact our Admin or Treasurer (emails are above) or visit the school website for the required form.

How can I be involved and have a say in Society business?

All parents and caregivers are welcome to be Society members. This provides you with the opportunity to receive updates as to what Society has been working on, attend our General Meetings, vote on important matters and be involved in other volunteer opportunities. There is an annual Society REGISTRATION FORM that needs to be completed. If you've completed one in the past, we have a condensed version to expedite the process for you.

What is the Society Executive focusing on this fall?

At this time we have 3 main areas of focus:

1. Master Partnership Agreement : We have a legal document between the FMCS Society and FMPSD regarding our school, which has been under review and revision this past year. This is still ongoing and we will be meeting with our members in the coming months to discuss and review.
2. Church Connections : We are so thankful for the churches in our community and have at least 14 of them represented in our school community. We want to take time and be intentional to build relationships, increase pastoral involvement in our school and help grow awareness of our school within the church congregations.
3. Development of Grades 10-12 : As the founders did 30 years ago, we are daring to dream bigger dreams and trust in God to expand our grade offerings in the near future. This will not be done by one, or even a handful of individuals, but will be the result of many coming together to make this possible!

In closing, if I may, I'd like to ask for you to keep the Executive and staff in prayer for this coming year. That we may lean in, and lean on Him, and be faithful and obedient as we desire and discern God's Will for His school.

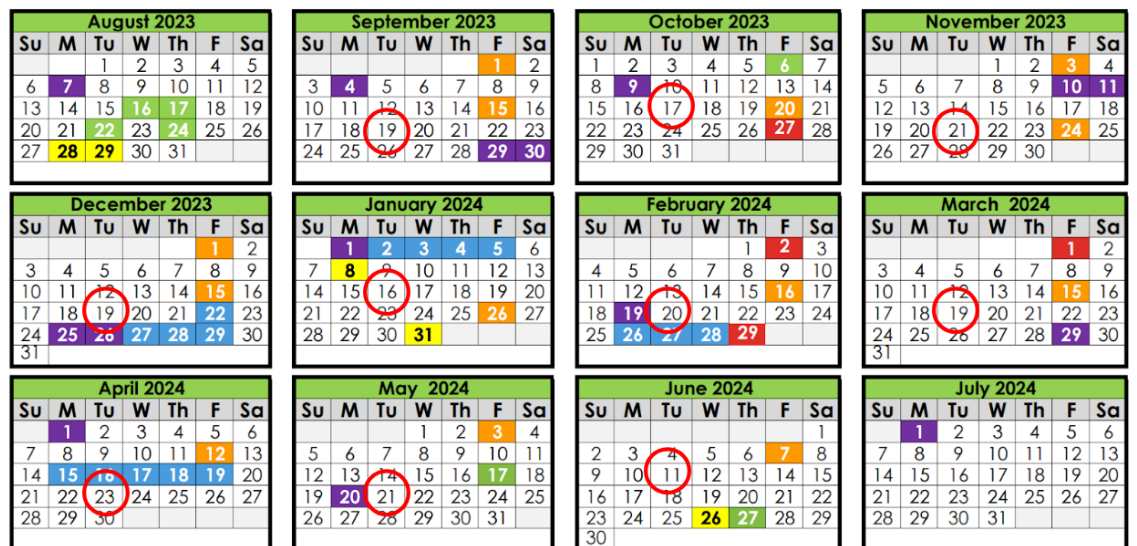

Volunteer Information

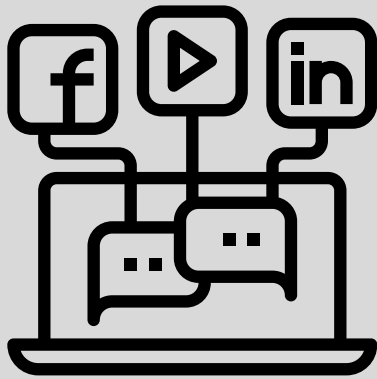
Volunteers are an important part of school. We are excited to be working with our School Council to recruit and provide volunteering opportunities.
