4. Education Plan - Geoff Bishop

- One of the biggest roles for School Council is to be advisory to the Principal.
- Have had conversations with teachers and this is what we are currently thinking/planning. We typically pick two things to focus on each year. (To be clear this is above and beyond the Christian Education aspect).
 - 1) Biggest thing being heard is that we want to keep literacy as a goal. There has been improvement, but still want to keep this a focus.
 - 2) Social Emotional Behavior Learning is the current umbrella of thought.
 - One part of this would be screen use:
 - There are large impacts for all ages that we are seeing with screens.
 - Cell phones have been a big issue in grades 5 and up. While they are not allowed, it's still an issue.
 - Need strategies and get parents on board with how to go about this.
 - Had a meeting with Johnathan Haidt from Let Grow. Talked about anxiety depression and suicide and how there is a high trend in these starting in 2012/2013, which is when cell phones became more popular. This company will provide a lot of the work for us and we just need to implement it.

- Basic premise giving teachers homework to students where they do stuff at home. Want to help parents build resiliency.
- Will be others under this umbrella.
- We need to collectively be on board with this so that it works.
- Geoff needs to have this finalized soon with all the wording right.

 - Would we also look at removing screens during lunch times and computer times?
